James H. McNeil, Jr., Akerman, LLP, Orangewood N-2 Planned Development / Land Use Plan (PD / LUP), Case # CDR-18-07-230, amend plan; District 1

Consideration: A PD substantial change to change the use of Parcel 11D from single-family residential to short-term rental in order to provide consistency with BCC condition of approval # 10 from June 30, 2015 and to remove the potential elementary school site from parcel 11D. In addition, the following two (2) waivers from Orange County Code are requested: 1. A waiver from 38-1203(3) is granted to allow the project to be governed by a Preliminary Subdivision Plan, in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 34, and any other applicable provisions of Orange County Code related to residential development, in lieu of the requirement to submit a Development Plan(s). 2. A waiver is granted to allow the project to be treated as a residential project and be governed by the standards in Chapter 38, Article VIII, related to Residential Site Standards, and any other applicable provisions of Orange County Code related to residential development, in lieu of the standards set forth in Chapter 38, Article VIII, and any other applicable provisions of Orange County Code related to Tourist Commercial Site Development Standards or commercial components of a planned development (PD); pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 30, Article III, Section 30-89 and Orange County Code, Chapter 38, Article VIII, Division 1, Section 38-1207.

Location: District 1, property generally located south of Central Florida Parkway and West of International Drive; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file in Planning Division)

A motion was made by Commissioner VanderLey, seconded by Commissioner Uribe, to make a finding of consistency with the Comprehensive Plan; and approve the substantial change request subject to the conditions of approval listed under the Development Review Committee recommendation in the Staff Report.
