SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" zones in the curves of Shale Ridge Trail from Beridale Court to Senjill Court.

Citizens within the Robinson Hill community have expressed concerns related to the ability of school buses to maneuver through the community when vehicles are parked on the street. Traffic Engineering staff contacted Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) and asked that they conduct a study. The results from the OCPS study showed that school buses did have issues maneuvering within the curves on Shale Ridge Trail from Beridale Court to Senjill Court when cars were parked on the street. Based on the findings from the study conducted by OCPS, Traffic Engineering recommends restricting parking on Shale Ridge Trail from Beridale Court to Senjill Court at all times.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" zones in the curves of Shale Ridge Trail from Beridale Court and Senjill Court.
