## **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval of Amendment No. 7, Contract Y16-1032, Bulk Rock Salt NOC-17F, with Morton Salt, Inc., for a 1-year renewal in the estimated amount of \$15,730.83, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$281,489.10.

## PROCUREMENT:

To provide bulk rock salt to the Utilities Department water treatment plants.

## **FUNDING**:

Funding is available in accounts 4420-038-1324-4149.

#### **APPROVALS:**

The Water Division concurs with this recommendation.

## <u>REMARKS</u>:

On April 29, 2016, the Board approved award of Contract Y16-1032 in the amount of \$216,000 for a one-year term, renewable for four additional one-year terms. Previous amendments to the contract are as follows:

Amendment No. 1:

Approved a price increase from \$135 per ton to \$140.39, for an annual

increase of \$8,624, for a revised total contract of \$224,624.

Amendment No. 2:

Increased annual tonnage from 1,600 tons to 1,743 tons for an annual

increase of \$20,075.77, for a revised total contract of \$244,699.77.

Amendment No. 3:

Renewed the contract for the period of April 29, 2017 through April 28,

2018.

Amendment No. 4: Renewed the contract for the period of April 29, 2018 through April 28, 2019.

Amendment No. 5: Was made null and void.

Amendment No. 6: Increased annual tonnage from 1,743 tons to 1,893 tons for an annual increase of \$21,058.50, for a revised total contract of \$265,758.27.
