### ACTION REQUESTED

Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y19-2011, Primary Medical Care Program, with Health Care Center for the Homeless, Inc. dba Orange Blossom Family Health, in the amount of \$250,000, for a revised total contract amount of \$345,757.

## **PROCUREMENT**

This amendment is necessary to provide funding for youth dental services.

#### **FUNDING**

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-3195.

#### **APPROVALS**

The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with this recommendation.

#### **REMARKS**

The Board approved this contract on September 18, 2018, in the amount of \$95,757 for a 1-vear term with two 1-vear renewal options.

During fiscal year 2017-2018, the Board commissioned the services of Forefront, LLC, an independent Florida-based consulting, research, and advisory firm, to provide recommendations for the utilization of \$20 million in new funding earmarked for children's programs and services in Orange County. Forefront, LLC published a final report outlining focus areas for targeted services of juvenile prevention and diversion, mental and physical health, early childhood education/care, and student homelessness. The report recommended that this programming should be provided in Orange County zip codes 32703, 32801, 32805, 32808, 32810, 32811, 32818, 32822, and 32839. The allocation of the available funding will occur in several phases.

The first phase of allocation will focus on the Citizens' Commission for Children currently contracted nonprofit organizations meeting contractual expectations. This amendment is part of the first phase.
