ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids, Y19-112-KB, Free Standing and Roof Top Radio Tower Maintenance, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Tower Systems South, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$341,600 for a 2-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contracts for two additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide maintenance for county radio tower sites.
