April 2019 Neighborhood Pride Sign Grants

The Neighborhood Services Division administers the Neighborhood Pride Grant Program that provides funds for citizen organizations to enhance the quality of their neighborhoods. The Neighborhood Pride Grants are available countywide in amounts ranging between \$1,500 to \$10,000. Neighborhood Pride Grant applications are accepted year-round and are reviewed monthly by the Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board (NGAB). The Neighborhood Pride Sign Grant Program provides funding to neighborhood residents, organizations, non-mandatory homeowner associations, and non-profit organizations for the installation or repair of a sign for a neighborhood.

The Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board (NGAB) is recommending approval of April 2019 Sign Grant to Good Homes Vista Neighborhood (\$5,000) (see Attachment A). The grant request is displayed in greater detail in Attachment B. The grant request was reviewed by staff and presented to the NGAB for recommendation. The application was reviewed based on project feasibility, organizational readiness, and benefit to the community. In addition, the application was reviewed against the County's permitting requirements to ensure that the project would comply with appropriate County codes.

The vendors responsible for permitting the signs have been instructed that a Maintenance of Traffic Permit may be required for each sign, depending on the location. These costs may be up to \$1,000 per sign and will be added to the amount of the grant.

Finally, the organizations are required to sign a letter of agreement recognizing their responsibilities throughout the grant process, document the appropriate match, and demonstrate an ability to maintain the project.
