Modify existing "No Parking" zone on both sides of Cypress Pavilion

Parkway to add "No Stopping" and "No Standing", and extend it

Approximately 600 feet west of Cypress Springs Elementary School entrance

The Orange County Sheriff's Office has requested Traffic Engineering extend the existing "No Parking" zone on both sides of Cypress Pavilion Parkway, to 600 feet west of the Cypress Springs Elementary School entrance. Currently, on-street parking is prohibited, but parents are stopping in the traveled way to let students out of their cars and avoid the parent drop-off/pickup loop. The school resource officer is concerned for the safety of both pedestrians and vehicles at this location.

The Traffic Engineering Division has determined that the drivers using the traveled way to drop off their children creates a traffic hazard for both pedestrians and drivers on Cypress Pavilion Parkway.

Staff recommends that the Board approve modifying the existing "No Parking" zone on both sides of Cypress Pavilion Parkway to add "No Stopping" and "No Standing" and to extend it 600 feet west of the Cypress Springs Elementary School entrance.
