RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate to provide Professional Engineering Services for the Final Design of Kennedy Boulevard (from West of Forest City Road {434} to Wymore Boulevard), Request for Proposals Y19-803-CH, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further request the Board authorize the execution of the final contract by the Procurement Division provided that it does not exceed the budget of \$1,000,000.

Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc. Kelly, Collins & Gentry, Inc.

The proposals were evaluated by the Procurement Committee on March 27, 2019. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this contract is to select a firm to provide professional engineering services for the final design of Kennedy Boulevard (from West of Forest City Road {434} to Wymore Boulevard).

DISCUSSION:

The consultant shall update the construction plans to current Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Orange County standards and to redesign the Kennedy Boulevard and Wymore Road intersection to accommodate the future Interstate 4 Ultimate configuration currently under construction by FDOT. The redesign includes approximately 1,600 feet of Kennedy Boulevard and feet of Wymore Road.

Page 2 of 2 Consultant Selection, Y19-803-CH, Professional Engineering Services for the Final Design of Kennedy Boulevard

The project will reconstruct a two-lane road into a four-lane divided urban roadway. The project begins just west of Forest City Road and proceeds east to Wymore Road for approximately 2.02 miles. Also included in the project are related improvements on Keller Road (0.18 miles), Lake Destiny Drive (0.211 miles), and Wymore Road (0.325 miles). The total project length is approximately 2.74 miles.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Request for Proposals. The consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.
