## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Selection of one firm and one ranked alternate for Avalon Road Reclaimed Water Storage and Repump Facilities, Request for Proposals Y19-807-TA, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further, request the Board authorize negotiation and execution of the final contract by the Procurement Division provided that it does not exceed the budget of \$1,800,000.

Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. Reiss Engineering, Inc. Wright-Pierce, Inc. WSP USA Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on March 20, 2019. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## **PURPOSE**

This project consists of the design, permitting, and construction administration of reclaimed water storage and pumping facilities necessary to address periods of peak reclaimed water volume usage in the southwest Service Area. The project includes 5.0 million gallons of reclaimed water storage and 21,000 gallons per minute of high service pumping. The facility will include variable speed pumps and controls housed in a building, instrumentation including Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition, disinfection system, emergency power generator, fuel storage tank, and miscellaneous appurtenances necessary for system operation. The facility will be located in District 1.

### DISCUSSION

Five proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.

The firm Booth, Em, Straughan & Hiott, Inc. scored too low for board consideration.
