## I. EXPLANATION & SUMMARY:

The Orange County Educational Facilities Authority (the "Authority") was established by the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") in 1996 pursuant to the Higher Educational Facilities Authorities Law, Chapter 243, Florida Statutes, and Ordinance No. 96-7. The Authority is a dependent special district which was created for the purpose of financing capital projects for institutions of higher education.

The Authority has been inactive for more than two years, has no assets or liabilities, has no outstanding bond issues and has no reasonable prospects for becoming active in the future. The two remaining members of the Authority requested that the Membership, Mission and Review Board ("MMRB") recommend that the Board pass an ordinance dissolving the Authority. On April 19, 2019, the MMRB unanimously voted to recommend dissolution of the Authority.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE ORANGE COUNTY EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY; REPEALING ORANGE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 96-7, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NOS. 2007-15 AND 2013-10 AND CODIFIED IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, DIVISION 7 OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FILING WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA SPECIAL DISTRICT ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM.

 WHEREAS, on April 2, 1996, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida (the "Board") enacted Ordinance 96-7 establishing the Orange County Educational
Facilities Authority (the "Authority"), which Ordinance was amended by Ordinance No. 2007-15 on December 18, 2007, and Ordinance No. 2013-10 on April 23, 2013, and is currently codified
in Chapter 2, Article V, Division 7 of the Orange County Code; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is a dependent special district pursuant to Section 189.012 18 Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 189.071, Florida Statutes, the Board, as the governing
body which created the Authority, has the power to dissolve the Authority by repealing the above enabling laws of the Authority; and

22 WHEREAS, the Authority has been inactive for more than two years, and has no reasonable prospects for becoming active in the future; and

WHEREAS, the sole remaining members of the Authority, by letter addressed to the Board dated April 5, 2019, requested that the Board dissolve the Authority on the basis that the Authority has no assets or liabilities, no outstanding bonded indebtedness, has been inactive for more than two years, and has no reasonable prospects for becoming active in the future; and

28 WHEREAS, the Board now desires to dissolve the Authority.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

### 30 ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: County Ordinance No. 96-7, as amended, by Ordinance Nos. 2007-15 and

32 2013-10 currently codified as Division 7 of Chapter 2, Article V of the Orange County is hereby

repealed in its entirety. The Orange County Educational Facilities Authority is therefore

4 dissolved.

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Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect pursuant to general law. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the State of Florida Special District Accountability Program within 30 days of taking effect.
