SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 10, Contract Y14-177A, Landscape Maintenance - Active and Inactive Water Plants

### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 10, Contract Y14-177A, Landscape Maintenance – Active and Inactive Water Plants, with D3 Enviroscape, LLC in the amount of \$34,916.10, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$226,216.10.

### PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will provide additional funding to meet the County's needs based on usage to date while a procurement process is completed.

### FUNDING

Funding is available in account 4420-038-1324-3810.

### APPROVALS:

The Water Division concurs with this recommendation.

### REMARKS:

On March 25, 2014, the Board approved award of Contract Y14-177 in the amount of \$141,300 for a one-year term, renewable for four additional one-year terms. Previous amendments to the contract are as follows:

Amendment No. 1: Renewed the contract for the period of May 4, 2015 through May 3, 2016.

Amendment No. 2: Added services at the Winter Garden Booster Station and Apopka Booster Station, for an increase to the contract of \$2,760, for a revised estimated total contract of \$144,060.

Amendment No. 3: Renewed the contract for the period of May 4, 2016 through May 3, 2017.

Amendment No. 4: Added services for the wooded section at Oak Meadows water plant, adjacent path to wells, and clearing the fence line, for an increase to the contract of \$4,800, for a revised estimated total contract of \$148,860.

Amendment No. 5: Added services for new buildings and surroundings at the Western Regional Active/Inactive Water Plant, for an increase to the contract of \$11,280, for a revised estimated total contract of \$160,140.

Amendment No. 6: Renewed the contract for the period of May 4, 2017 through May 3, 2018.

Amendment No. 7: Added services to the monitoring wells at County Road 535, for an increase to the contract of \$300, for a revised estimated total contract of \$160,440.

Amendment No. 8: Renewed the contract for the period of May 4, 2018 through May 3, 2019.

Amendment No. 9: Extended the contract through September 30, 2019 to allow time for solicitation and Board approval.
