SUBJ: Establishment of a Multi-way Stop Condition at the Intersection of Beulah Road and Marshall Farms Road/Beard Road.

A concerned citizen requested that the Traffic Engineering Division review the traffic control at the intersection of Beulah Road and Marshall Farms Road/Beard Road.

Traffic Engineering conducted a multi-way stop study, which consisted of an evaluation of existing field conditions including critical approach speed, sight distance, traffic volumes, and crash history. To improve safety, staff recommends that the existing two-way stop control be converted to a multi-way stop control at the intersection of Beulah Road and Marshall Farms Road/Beard Road.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a multi-way stop condition at Beulah Road and Marshall Farms Road/Beard Road.


Action Requested: Approval of multi-way stop installation at Beulah Road and Marshall Farms Road/Beard Road. District 1.
