



 Maintained 240 miles of fiber optic cable for signals

Resurfacing program will continue at a 15-year cycle for local roads and a 12-year cycle for arterial and collector roads







Right-of-Way and Retention Ponds

- Between April and October, mowing cycles are increased to 10 cycles (every 2-3 weeks each)
- Between November and March, mowing cycles are reduced to 6 cycles (every 3-4 weeks each)
- Total of 16 cycles per year







Street sweeping remains at a 5 to 6 week cycle





Tree trimming – as needed Drainage rehabilitation – as needed







- School zones and flashers installed as needed
- Traffic signals warranted signals scheduled for installation
- Traffic calming devices MSBU's with matching funds
- Response to Reported Traffic Signal Malfunctions, Downed Stop and Yield Signs Level of Service Unchanged





Programs

- Pedestrian Safety Program
 - Monitor, evaluate, identify and address locations requiring safety improvements
 - Continue pedestrian outreach and education awareness programs

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

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


Public Works CIP Budget



Roadway Lighting Program

- 44 miles of roadway lighted to date
- 19 roads totaling 41 miles are with the utility companies for design and construction
- This will complete 85 miles in the current program





Unlit Roads

- 166 miles of unlit county collector and arterial roads
 - 155 miles of 2 lane roads
 - 11 miles of 4 & 6 lanes
- 24 additional unlit miles are planned with future CIP widening projects
- \$18M future program
- \$1.7M annual maintenance
