- East Orange District Park
 - 243 acre park
 - 2 multipurpose fields, recreation center, & concession
 - Project substantially complete
 - Grand opening April 2019

Barnett Park Improvements

- Lighting
 - Add parking lot lights at multi-purpose fields
 - Upgrade lights at tennis courts
 - Completed May 2019
- Entrance Sign
 - Replace existing with new LED Sign

- Horizon West Master Plan Update & Design
 - Consultant selected for master plan and design
 - Master planning process is underway and concludes February 2020
 - Phase I design will immediately follow









- Magnolia Park Ecotourism Center
 - Installation of concession building, pavilion, dock, parking, etc.
 - Design underway
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2020








- Barber Park Multipurpose Fields
 - Construction of 2 multipurpose fields underway
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2019







- Barber Park Splash Pad
 - Construction underway
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2019









- Parcel J Property Multipurpose Field (property near Moss Park)
 - 3 multipurpose fields
 - Concession/Restroom
 - Design complete
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2020





- Lakeside Village Park Phase 2
 - Phase 1 Opened 2018
 - 9 acres total (Ph. I & Ph. II)
 - Trail extension, picnic tables, playground, small pavilions
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2020





- Blanchard Park Parking Lot
 - Replace existing dirt parking areas with asphalt and sidewalks
 - Estimated completion date Winter 2021





- Little Econ Greenway Trail (Gap)
 - Provides connection to Cady Way Trail
 - Forsyth Rd. to Semoran Blvd.
 - Feasibility Study phase underway
 - Estimated completion date Summer 2022

- Taborfield (Bentonshire) Neighborhood Park
 - APF park in Horizon West
 - Design currently underway
 - Estimated completion date Fall 2020
 - Total cost = \$200,000





- Pine Castle Little League Field Renovations
 - Property to be donated to County
 - Operate as a public park
 - Renovate fields to be multi-purpose fields
 - Total cost = \$2,530,000





- Bithlo Community Center expansion
 - Development of a 1,700 sq. ft. addition
 - Multi-purpose fitness room
 - Total cost = \$594,000






- Dr. Phillips Little League Fields
 - Coordinating with OCPS and Kerina Development to relocate Dr. Phillips Little League Fields to middle school site





- Harrod Property
 - Acquisition of property located on the Little Econ River in East Orange County
 - Limited passive park
 - \$2.5M County (Countywide Parks INVEST)
 - \$2.5M State grant for acquisition
 - \$500,000 State Grant for Development







- Riverside Acres Park Improvements
 - Additional trees, picnic tables, grills, community garden and playground improvements
 - Total cost = \$100,000






- Pickleball Courts
 - Construct pickleball courts at Downey Park
 - Total cost = \$330,000





- Barber Park Recreation Center
 - Develop recreation center to meet the needs of the community
 - Completes master plan of the park
 - Design FY 19/20
 - Estimated completion date 2021
 - Total cost = \$6,600,000





- Clarcona Horse Park Show Ring Cover
 - 5 acre park
 - Design FY 19/20
 - Estimated completion date 2021
 - Total cost = \$1,232,000





- Barnett Park and West Orange Park Exercise Course
 - Replacing Parcourse with new equipment
 - Estimated completion date July 2020
 - Total cost = \$300,000





- Land acquisition
 - \$2,000,000
