SUBJ: Establishment of a Stop Controlled One-way Roadway on Taylor Creek

Road from 185 feet north to 185 feet south of Culvert Headwall #BISJR054

The Christmas Civic Association requested that the Traffic Engineering Division review safety on Taylor Creek Road from Colonial Drive to State Road 520.

Traffic Engineering staff performed a traffic study and found that safety can be improved by the installation of a one-way roadway from 185 feet north to 185 feet south of culvert headwall #BISJR054. Each of the approaches of the one-way only roadway will be controlled by a Stop sign. The purpose of the one-way only roadway is to improve safety for vehicles on Taylor Creek Road approaching the culvert headwall and reduce vehicle speeds.

Staff recommends that the Board approve a Stop controlled one-way roadway on Taylor Creek Road from 185 feet north to 185 feet south of culvert headwall #BISJR054.

Action Requested: Approval of a Stop Controlled one-way roadway on Taylor Creek Road from 185 feet north to 185 feet south of culvert headwall #BISJR054. District 5.


