ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y19-700-CH, North Fort Christmas Road Safety Improvements Project – FPN: 437458-1-58-01 FAN: D518-008-B, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Southern Development & Construction, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$933,000.

PROCUREMENT:

This project involves the construction of a 6-foot shoulder (4-foot paved, 2-foot unpaved), resurfacing of the travel lanes, and correcting cross-slopes in the areas of reverse curves to the extent feasible in order to enhance safety, drainage improvements, and ditch regrading. The total length of this project is approximately 1,975 linear feet or 0.374 mile. The project is located in District 5.

FUNDING:

This project will be funded by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Funding is available in account numbers: 7528-072-7371-6311 and 1023-072-5142-6311.

REMARKS:

Two bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The solicitation was conducted in accordance with FDOT's competitive procurement for construction services with the Local Agency Program Agreement. The County's M/WBE program is not applicable for this procurement.

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Staff evaluated the bids and determined that the low bid is reasonable. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Southern Development & Construction, Inc. has been determined to be responsible. FDOT concurs with the recommendation of award to Southern Development & Construction, Inc. Therefore, award is recommended to Southern Development & Construction, Inc.
