Further, request the Board authorize negotiation and execution of a contract by the Procurement Division provided that the contract does not exceed the budget of \$6,000,000.

Black & Veatch Corporation Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on October 9, 2019. Commissioner Mayra Uribe was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

### **PURPOSE:**

This project consists of the design, permitting, and construction administration for the construction of various improvements to the SWRF that includes a new electrical/generator building; south service area pump station improvements; a new central receiving building; new Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition control room; maintenance building renovations; North 1 Aeration Basin modifications; North Plant Grating and handrail; Anaerobic digester Exterior Renovations, and north plant effluent pumps and motors refurbishment. Sustainability components include repairing aging water infrastructure, more efficient use of water, and improving water treatment performance. The work is located in District 6.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Two proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.
