ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y20-715-CH, University Boulevard and Forsyth Road Intersection Improvements, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Stage Door II, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$323,571.50.

PROCUREMENT:

The project consists of providing intersection improvements at University Boulevard and Forsyth Road. The northwest and northeast turn radii will be reduced to 50 feet and the pedestrian crosswalks will be moved back to shorten the crossing distance. The stop bars on the north, east and west legs will be moved back about 10 feet to 15 feet. The project length is approximately 250 feet and is located in District 5.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number: 1003-072-2722-6311.

APPROVALS:

The Public Works Engineering Division, Highway Construction Division, and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid of Blacktip Services, Incorporated was found non-responsive for not providing a general contractor's license or an underground utility and excavation contractor's license. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Stage Door II, Inc. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Stage Door II, Inc.

The Business Development Division evaluated the three bids submitted for this project. None of the bidders was an Orange County certified Minority/Women Business Enterprise. The scope of services for this project had Minority/Women Business Enterprise availability. At the time of bid opening, at least 36 M/WBE firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bidder, Stage Door II, Inc., met the M/WBE participation goal and reported 29.85% M/WBE participation in their bid. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The second low bid submitted by Condor Construction, Corp., did not achieve good faith effort documentation and reported 7.49% M/WBE participation in their bid.

The third low bid submitted by Florida Safety Contractors, Inc., did not achieve good faith effort documentation. While the third low bidder reported \$112,449 in M/WBE participation, they did not specify the work to be performed on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed.

None of the bids were within the M/WBE sliding scale range to be awarded this contract over the low bidder.

Our evaluation of these bids was based on the participation listed on the subcontractor/supplier page. If the low bidder is not chosen, please let us know so that we may obtain Letters of Intent to confirm the participation.
