The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$7,500 from the FY 2020 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

National Latino Peace Officers Association, Central Florida Chapter – \$2,500. This charitable organization is comprised of law enforcement officers and civilian personnel from different agencies in the Central Florida area. The organization's primary dedication to the community is to provide children and young adults with educational and community service opportunities. Each year, this organization sponsors a "Three Kings Day Celebration" that distributes toys to children from under-privileged families. These children are selected from referrals submitted by school resource officers, children's advocate groups, and local ministries. This also gives the children the opportunity to interact with law enforcement officers in a positive manner.

Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program -\$5,000. The "Cops and Kids" program enables under-privileged and at-risk children the opportunity to go shopping with law enforcement officers at Christmas time to pick out gifts for themselves and their family members. These children are selected from referrals submitted by school resource officers; children advocate groups; and local ministries. ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$7,500 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to National Latino Peace Officers Association, Central Florida Chapter (\$2,500) and Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program (\$5,000).

PLEASE NOTE:

The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 28% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at yearend. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
