The Roads and Drainage Division has requested "No Parking" signs be installed on both sides of Brownell Street 90 feet east of North Apopka Boulevard on the north side of Brownell Street and from North Apopka Boulevard to North Orange Blossom Trail on the south side.


Traffic Engineering staff have determined that the parking of vehicles along the unpaved shoulder of Brownell Street is damaging the roadway. The increased number of trucks has caused pavement failure and shoulder erosion creating unstable drop-off conditions; therefore, staff recommends the installation of "No Parking" signs.

Staff recommends the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs on Brownell Street 90 feet east of North Apopka Boulevard on the north side of Brownell Street and from North Apopka Boulevard to North Orange Blossom Trail on the south side.
