RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and two ranked alternates to provide Commissioning Services for the Orange County Convention Center North/South Building Improvements, Request for Proposals Y20-903-JS, from the following firms, listed alphabetically. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute the final contract to establish hourly rates for future requirements and to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms.

EXP U.S. Services, Inc. FCM Engineering Graef-USA Inc. Hanson Professional Services Inc.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on January 15, 2020. Commissioner Victoria P. Siplin was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

To select one firm for negotiation of a contract to provide commissioning services for the Convention Center North/South Building Improvements. This project is located in District 6.

DISCUSSION:

The objective of this commissioning service contract is to improve building systems performance as prescribed by the project documents and in accordance with LEED project goals by developing and executing a testing plan, observing performance, and documenting performance to ensure that performance criteria is met and energy savings can be achieved. The focus of this contract shall be on the functional testing, testing and balancing verification, and training to ensure that building systems are performing in accordance with the plans, specifications, and commissioning specifications.

Four firms submitted proposals in response to this solicitation. The scores of the Procurement Committee are attached.
