WHEREAS, pursuant to procedures adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, a petition was filed with the Board to vacate that certain 100 foot wide open, non-maintained right-of-way known as Maria Avenue, containing approximately 0.62 acres in Orange County, Florida, as described in attachment.

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners on **January 28**, **2020**, was published in the **Orlando Sentinel**, a newspaper of general circulation in Orange County, Florida, one time at least two weeks prior to the date for the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the vacating of 100 foot wide open, non-maintained right-ofway known as Maria Avenue, containing approximately 0.62 acres will not operate to the detriment of Orange County or the public.
