Design Services for Orange County Animal Services Facility

RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of Bacon Group, Inc. to provide Design Services for Orange County Animal Services Facility, Request for Proposals Y20-811-RC. Further, request the Board to authorize the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute the final contract, provided that it does not exceed the budget of \$2,500,000.

Proposals were evaluated by the Procurement Committee on January 22, 2020. Commissioner Victoria P. Siplin was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this contract is to select a firm to provide design services for Orange County Animal Services facility.

DISCUSSION:

The project consists of design services for a new animal services facility of approximately 50,000–70,000 square feet. The new facility will include administrative/office spaces, separate feline and canine adoption areas, separate feline and canine kennel areas, isolation areas/canine holding areas, surgery/operating rooms, surrender area, and interaction yards. Utilities, including sanitary and water, will be designed to accommodate the anticipated needs of the building functions and meet code requirements.

Two proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. The Proposal submitted by MLM-Martin Architects, Inc. scored too low for Board consideration.
