AUTHORIZATION TO CONVEY CERTAIN COUNTY PROPERTY INTERESTS TO THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 125.38, FLORIDA STATUTES

Resolution No. 20<u>20</u> - <u>M-04</u>

WHEREAS, Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (the "County"), pursuant to its home rule power and Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, has authority to determine that certain County property is not needed for County purposes and to convey said property, for nominal price or otherwise, to the United States or any department or agency thereof, the State or any political subdivision or agency thereof, or any municipality of Florida, or any corporation or non-profit entity organized for the purpose of promoting community interest and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the County has an interest in the land more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto (the "Parcel"); and

WHEREAS, The School Board of Orange County, Florida, a public corporate body and political subdivision of the State of Florida (the "School Board") has applied to the County for the conveyance of any and all of County's interest in the Parcel for the purposes of development of site improvements for the relief high school known as Site #113-H-W-4; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the County's interest in the Parcel is no longer needed for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that, pursuant to the School Board's application, the County's interest in the Parcel should be conveyed to the School Board, and such conveyance is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is qualified, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, to make application for, and receive, this County property pursuant to Section 125.38, Florida Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. The Board hereby determines that the Parcel is no longer needed for County purposes, and it is in the best interests of the County to convey the Parcel to the School Board for the purposes of development of site improvements for the relief high school known as Site #113-H-W-4.

Section 3. The Board hereby directs that all of the County's right, title, and interest in the Parcel be conveyed to the School Board for the consideration of \$1.

Section 4. The Board hereby directs the Mayor to execute and deliver a County Deed in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "B" to effectuate such conveyance and staff to do all things necessary and appropriate to conclude this transaction.

Section 5. The Board hereby directs staff to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the School Board.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Board.




