- SUBJECT: Award of Invitation for Bids Y20-158-AV, Temporary Labor for Skilled General Maintenance

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y20-158-AV, Temporary Labor for Skilled General Maintenance, to the two low responsive and responsible bidders, Personnel Solutions Plus, LLC, in the estimated contract award amount of \$3,580,890 and Moten Tate, Incorporated in the estimated contract award amount of \$3,647,000 for the base year. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contracts for option years one and two.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide skilled general maintenance staffing for events held at the Convention Center.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4430-035-0922-3197.

APPROVALS:

The Orange County Convention Center and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids (IFB) and were evaluated for price, responsiveness, and responsibility. Top Talent Staffing, LLC was deemed non-responsive for failure to submit required documentation. Hire Quest, L.L.C. was deemed non-responsive for failing to submit a complete bid response form.

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In accordance with the IFB, the County reserves the right to make multiple all-ornone awards. Due to the need to support multiple events simultaneously in all three convention center buildings, it is vital to have multiple contracts to provide these labor services.

Staff performed a technical evaluation of the bids and determined that each low bid was reasonable based on performance and experience. Moten Tate, Incorporated is a certified M/WBE firm whose bid is within the 4% allowed by the solicitation for award to other than the low bidder, in accordance with the County's M/WBE Ordinance, Section 17-324. As a result, Moten Tate, Incorporated will be established as the primary contractor. Personnel Solutions Plus, LLC will be established as the secondary contractor.

The primary shall be given the first opportunity to provide labor services; however, if they decline due to the inability to provide labor, the secondary, shall be given the opportunity to provide labor services. The bidders were determined to be the low responsive and responsible bidders for the items listed and were recommended for award.

The Business Development Division evaluated the **two bids** submitted for this project and found that this contract may be awarded to **Moten Tate Incorporated** a Certified Minority/Women Business Enterprise firm. At the time of bid opening at least five firms were certified at the prime level in the scope of service. The Orange County Certified Minority Business Enterprise firm did not exceed the low bid by more than 4% on contract awards from \$2,000,000 to \$5,000,000. Hence, the bid preference program in accordance with the County's M/WBE Ordinance, Section 17-324 can be applied.
