## Background

#### 2018

 Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety Act

#### 2019

- FSS 1006.12 "Safe-School Officers at each public school" implementation
- Bell to bell coverage (30 min prior and 30 min after)

## **OCPS 2019-2021 Contract**

#### 2019-2020 School Year

- 155 SRO positions, not including supervisors
- \$49,000 per SRO position
- Average Deputy SRO (Salary and Benefits) \$107,860\*

#### **2020-2021 School Year**

- 155 SRO positions, not including supervisors
- \$50,000 per SRO position
- Projected Deputy SRO (Salary and Benefits)
  \$113,100\*

# **Staffing Process**

- Application and Hiring (3 5 months)
- Academy (20 weeks)
- Basic Recruit Training (9 weeks)
- Field Training Phase 1 (14 weeks)
- Fully Independent probationary deputy

Start to Finish it takes approximately 16 months for a civilian to become an independent deputy sheriff

## **Guardian Program**

OCSO provides training for all School Guardians who work for schools not part of the OCPS Contract

- 144 hours of training include:
  - Firearms Instruction
  - Active Shooter scenarios
  - Defensive Tactics
  - Legal Issues
- 12 Guardians trained in 2019

## **Future Requests**

 As new schools are added within OCSO jurisdiction, additional positions will be requested

 Staffing effectiveness will continue to be evaluated so other OCSO operational components are not adversely impacted

## **Action Requested**

 Action Requested: Approve the increase in OCSO authorized staffing by 19 deputy sheriff positions to fulfill the terms of the OCSO-OCPS School Resource Officer Program.
