The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) will hold a Public Hearing for the Orlando South Ultimate Interchange Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for proposed improvements at Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) and Beachline Expressway (SR 528) in Orange County, Florida (Financial Project Identification Number 438547-1). The Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, at The Florida Hotel and Conference Center, 1500 Sand Lake Road, Orlando, FL 32809. The meeting will begin as an open house at 5:30 p.m. in the Legacy North 2 Ballroom, with a formal presentation at 6:30 p.m. in the Legacy North 1 Ballroom, followed by a public comment period.

During the open house, interactive displays, maps and other information developed by FDOT to describe the preferred alternative and proposed access modifications will be available for review. The formal presentation will include an informational video on the project. We invite your comments on the proposed improvements. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions during the open house.

The Public Hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. Potential right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements including proposed stormwater ponds will be displayed at the Public Hearing.
