Application for Federal Assistance related to Coronavirus Aid,

Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, FY 2019-2020

The Head Start Division requests Board approval of the Application for Federal Assistance related to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, FY 2019-2020 between the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Office of Head Start and Orange County.

The legislation includes up to \$500 million for Head Start programs to operate supplemental summer programs. This one-time supplement grant funds in the amount of \$627,828 will be used to extend the current Summer Program at designated Head Start sites from July 1, 2020 through July 30, 2020. The primary purpose of the supplemental summer programs is to make up for time children lost as a result of program closures due to COVID-19.

The total supplemental grant funds in the estimated amount of \$627,828 will be used to cover the cost of staff salaries in the amount of \$375,270.20; FICA \$27,244.62; retirement \$30,997; and insurance \$134,316; and \$50,000 for supplies and materials and support for families to bring their children up-to-date on needed medical, dental, and other follow-up services. The non-federal match will be general from donations of goods and services and in-kind contributions from the County.
