## Substantial Change

Abdul Alkadry, Harris Civil Engineers, LLC, Vineland Pointe Planned Development / Land Use Plan (PD / LUP), Case # CDR-19-09-310, amend plan; District 1

**Consideration:** A PD substantial change to request the following two (2) waivers from Orange County Code. 1) A waiver from Section 38-1287(2) to allow for a PD building setback of twenty-five (25) feet, in lieu of the side setback of thirty (30) feet along the northeast edge of Parcel II and the northwest edge of Parcel III between the Parcel and the FDOT ponds. 2) A waiver from Section 38-1287 (1) to allow for the PD building setback of twenty-five (25) feet, in lieu of the side setback of seventy-five (75) feet along the northwest edge of Parcel II and the northwest edge of Parcel and the FDOT right-of-way; pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 38, Article VIII, Division 1, Section 38-1207.

Location: District 1; property generally located north of Lake Street, south of Lake Willis Drive, and east of Interstate 4; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file in Planning Division)
