Section 1. Repeal of Article VI ("Micromobility Devices") of Chapter 35

("Traffic"). Article VI of Chapter 35 of the Orange County Code that established a moratorium on the use of micromobility devices is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective pursuant to general law.
