4 ORDINANCE NO. 2020-6 AN **ORDINANCE AMENDMENT PERTAINING** TO **MINORITY/WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE** PARTICIPATION, DELETING SECTION 17-321(D) FROM 8 CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE III, ORANGE COUNTY CODE, 10 DIVISION 4, SECTION 17-321 ("CONTRACT AND SUBCONTRACT GOALS") AND PROVIDING FOR **CODIFICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 12 14 WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") has a demonstrated compelling government interest in remedying past and current discrimination in 16 the procurement of goods and services by Orange County, Florida (the "County"); and 18 WHEREAS, in Chapter 17, Article III, Division 4 of the Orange County Code (the "Minority/Business Enterprise Ordinance") the Board established contracting and 20 subcontracting participation goals for minority and women business enterprises ("M/WBE(s)") that are related to the County's procurement of construction, professional services, other 22 services, and goods (the "M/WBE Participation Goal(s)"); and 24 WHEREAS, under certain circumstances, subsection (d) of Section 17-321, Orange County Code, requires that the County award construction contracts to firms that have neither: 26 (1) met the County's M/WBE Participation Goal; nor (2) made a good faith effort in assisting the County in meeting its M/WBE Participation Goals; and 28 WHEREAS, based on lower than desired achievement of the M/WBE Participation Goal 30 related to construction contracts, the Board now finds it necessary to amend Section 17-321, Orange County Code, to remove that above-referenced requirement.
