Consultant Selection, Request for Proposals Y20-833-CH, Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) and Compliance Services for the Oakland Roundabout Construction Project

RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate to provide Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) and Compliance Services for the Oakland Roundabout Construction Project, Request for Proposals Y20-833-CH. Further, request the Board authorize negotiation and execution of a contract by the Procurement Division provided that the contract does not exceed the budget of \$299,000.

- AE Engineering, Inc.
- CDM Smith, Inc.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on September 16, 2020. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

The Consultant shall assist the County by providing project management, CEI, and compliance services for the Oakland Roundabout Construction project. The project is located in District 1.

The services to be performed include, but are not limited to:

- Shop drawings review and approval, interpretation of plans and specifications to respond to information requests, claim and construction schedule review and recommendation, daily inspection services and reporting, monitoring for adherence to County, State, safety and permitting standards.
- Compliance services shall include, but are not limited to, monitoring the compliance requirements in accordance with Required Contract Provisions Federal Aid Contracts (FHWA 1273) and compliance oversight program established by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The CEI Services is not funded by FDOT. However, the Oakland Roundabout construction project may be funded by FDOT.
- Perform geotechnical/material testing services as may be necessary.
