The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$32,500 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Camaraderie Foundation - \$2,500. This organization's mission is to positively impact the lives of all branches of Post - 9/11 Veterans, Service Members, and their families, by providing free counseling, support, and camaraderie when they need it the most.

Victim Services - \$20,000. This organization's mission is to provide comprehensive services to victims, next of kin, and witnesses of crime. One of the challenges faced by the Victim Advocate Squad is the lack of funding available to sufficiently assist victims and survivors of crime.

Holocaust Memorial Resource and Education Center of Florida - \$5.000. This organization is dedicated to combating antisemitism, racism, and prejudice, with the ultimate goal of developing a moral and just community through its extensive outreach of educational and cultural programs.

IDignity - \$5,000. This organization assists citizens in our community in regaining access to their legal identification documents. Their mission is to reduce the likelihood of individuals committing crimes and assist the Orange County Sheriff's Office in being able to properly identify those in our community.
