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Orange County COVID-19 Help is Here - Accelerated

- CareerSource Central Florida and Valencia College will deploy upskilling/retraining programs starting 11/2
- 10 courses vary in career paths such as advanced manufacturing, healthcare, and distribution/logistics
- 150+ recently furloughed/laid off hospitality background individuals will be recruited
- Once certifications are complete, immediate job opportunities are available
- Participants receive tuition and necessary supplies, wrap-around services and stipends to succeed with program



CARES Funding Deadline – December 30, 2020

- Costs <u>incurred</u> during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and end on December 30, 2020
 - For costs to be considered to have been <u>incurred</u>, performance or delivery must occur during the covered period.
 - Payment of funds need not be made during that time, though it is generally expected payments will be made within 90 days of a cost being incurred.
 - The Treasury does not have authority on extending the eligible use period absent Congressional action.

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
