- FDOT Amendment to FY2020/21-2024/25 TIP (Roll Call Vote)
 - -This amendment increases funding for utilities relocation for the interchange improvement at I-4 and Sand Lake Road from a total of \$4,250,000 to a total of \$12,220,00
 - The amendment also increases the total funding for the construction phase of the interchange from \$143 million to \$177 million





Other Action Items

- Approval to support Performance Measures and Targets
 - Approval is requested for the re-support of the FDOT performance targets for safety, bridge & pavement condition, travel time reliability, LYNX transit asset management targets and transit safety targets
 - Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration require MPOs to support the Performance Measure targets annually and bi-annually







- Approval of the Draft Regional Transportation Systems
 Management and Operations (TSMO) Program and authorizing the Executive Director execute the final draft.
 - —MetroPlan is the lead on a regional program to develop and facilitate a multi-regional innovative planning effort to improve safety, efficiency and performance of the transportation system. The MOU is between the MPOs of MetroPlan, Pinellas, Hillsborough, Pasco, Polk, Sarasota/Manatee, Space Coast and River to the Sea.



Approval of legislatives priorities for 2021

- —Top priorities
 - Seek funding for the expansion of the Best Foot Forward pedestrian safety program
 - Change existing laws t include bicyclists as vulerable road users in current Move Over Law (316.126 F.S.)

Support

- Exception to use drone technology for traffic incident management and emergency response
- Protect the State Transportation Trust Fund
- Protect Transportation Disadvantaged funding for paratransit (ACCESS LYNX) service
- Flexibility in the use of local option discretion taxes (Local Government Infrastructure Surtax)
