RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of three firms and two ranked alternates to provide Continuing Professional Geotechnical Engineering and Materials Testing Services, Request for Proposals Y21-900-CH, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further recommend the Board authorize execution of the final contracts by the Procurement Division to establish hourly rates for future requirements for a one-year term with two one-year renewals.

- Ardaman & Associates, Inc.
- Geotechnical and Environmental Consultants, Inc.
- Professional Service Industries, Inc.
- Terracon Consultants, Inc.
- Universal Engineering Sciences, LLC

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on February 3, 2021. Commissioner Nicole Wilson was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

The contracts will provide continuing professional geotechnical engineering and materials testing services throughout the County.

DISCUSSION:

The services will include subsurface investigation of soil and water conditions, field and lab evaluation, and testing of subsurface materials conditions. The Consultants shall also provide consultation and recommendation on foundation related design and on construction contract materials quality control requirements and other geotechnical engineering services as required by Orange County.

Consultant Selection, Request for Proposals Y21-900-CH, Continuing Professional Geotechnical Engineering and Materials Testing Services
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Three contracts are necessary due to the amount of projected work required within the next three years. Also, in keeping with the Board's policy to spread the work around, these contracts will be monitored to ensure a reasonable degree of equitable distribution of contract dollars.

There will be, however, occasions when the continued use of a particular consultant is necessary which may impact the distribution of contract dollars. These situations include the following:

- Continuation of services initially performed by a particular consultant.
- Services for which a particular consultant is uniquely qualified.
- Documented difficulty in obtaining proposals from other consultants.
- Documented difficulty in negotiating task authorizations with other consultants.
- Other justified reasons.

Six proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. The proposal submitted by NV5, Inc. scored too low for Board consideration.

Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.
