FDOT Amendment to FY2020/21-2024/25 TIP (Roll Call Vote)

- \$14,000 grant for preventive maintenance for LYNX vehicles (transportation for adults with disabilities in Osceola County)
- \$40,483 for pedestrian gates (railroad crossing in Winter Garden) and
 \$2,848 for LED lights (railroad crossing in Lake Mary)
- \$425,420 construction of the Quail Pond Circle pedestrian facilities and shared use path in Casselberry
- \$2,000,000 for PD&E study to identify potential locations for truck parking facilities in the MetroPlan area and/or Volusia County



Florida Turnpike Enterprise Amendment to the FY 2020/21-FY 2024/25 TIP (Roll Call Vote)

- Provides \$3,026,197 for the installation of infrastructure for the deployment of connected vehicles on sections of the Florida Turnpike and SR 528.
 - Deployment of roadside units and other vehicle detection systems to facilitate communications to and from connected vehicles. Safety features include curve speed warnings, queue warnings, wrong way detection and stopped/disabled vehicle warnings



Approval of MetroPlan Orlando Emphasis Areas (Board Priorities)

 Support of the existing set of emphasis areas, or modify them to be used when prioritizing projects for programming

Current Emphasis Areas:

- 1. Safety
- 2. Trail Connectivity
- 3. Complete Streets
