Wekiwa Springs Septic to Sewer Program Update

The Wekiva River and Wekiwa Springs are impaired by nutrients

- -Phosphorus
- -Nitrogen
- Excess nutrients cause excess algae
 - -Fish kills
 - Reduction of diversity, plants and animals






 In 2016, the Florida Springs and Aquifer Protection Act required an update to the Wekiwa Springs and Rock Springs Basin Management Action Plan (BMAP)

-Requires specific nutrient load reductions within 5, 10 and 15 years of BMAP

- Identified septic tanks as the source of 29% of nitrogen in the springs
- 18,000 septic tanks within Orange County Utilities' service area inside the Priority Focus Area (PFA)
- Board of County Commissioners work sessions on 4/21/2020 and 10/13/2020
 - Presented a 15 year program to replace septic tanks closest to Wekiwa Springs within the PFA




 Eliminate septic tanks in 17 neighborhoods closest to Wekiwa Springs
 -2,057 septic tanks
 -15 year plan
 -\$123 million






Phase 1 Central Sewer Layout






Phase 1 Central Water Layout





Cost: \$10.08 Million





- MSBU Balloting Results
 - -163 out of 211 voted "YES" (77%) > 67% required
 - -\$6,000 per parcel (paid by homeowner)
 - -Financed over a 10 year period
 - \$702.30 annual assessment
 - 2.9% interest rate
- Two Upcoming Public Hearings
 - -Establishment of MSBU
 - -Budget hearing (September)




