### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Selection of Liquid Solutions Group, LLC to provide Alternative Water Supply Consumptive Use Permitting Services, Request for Proposals Y21-903-TA. Further, request authorization for the negotiation and execution of a final contract by the Procurement Division to establish hourly rates for future requirements. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on March 10, 2021. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## **PURPOSE:**

The contract will provide continuing alternative water supply consumptive use permitting services for Orange County Utilities (OCU) on an as-needed basis. This contract will provide permitting and general consulting services to assist OCU in evaluating and implementing alternative water supply projects. This includes, but is not limited to, facilities for potable water supply, reclaimed water, surface water supply, conjunctive use of multiple sources, lake augmentation, brackish water supply, aquifer recharge, stormwater supply, reservoir storage, desalination, and aquifer storage and recovery.

## **DISCUSSION:**

One proposal was received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). To ensure an open and competitive procurement process, the RFP was posted on the Orange County website. Queries were made to prospective proposers including CPH Corporation and Tetra Tech, Inc. These firms indicated that this is not work usually performed by them and declined to compete for this contract. This work is of a specialized nature.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposal in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.
