ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y21-115-MV, Thompson Pumps, Parts and Repairs, to the sole responsive and responsible bidder, United Rentals (North America, Inc.), in the estimated contract award amount of \$1,086,735 for a three-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide parts and repair support for county-owned Thompson pumps.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 5530-043-2035-4164 and 4410-038-1025-3820.

APPROVALS:

The Facilities Management and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

One bid was received in response to this Invitation for Bids (IFB) and was evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. To ensure an open and competitive bid process, the IFB was posted on the Orange County website. A query to known potential bidders that declined to participate in the bidding opportunity resulted in the following findings:

- Thompson Pump and Manufacturing Company: In 2019, all Thompson Pump and Manufacturing Company's rental assets were purchased by the United Rentals Fluid Solutions Division. Thompson Pump and Manufacturing Company cannot legally rent the equipment they manufacture.
- Summit Aerospace did not respond to the inquiry.
- Southern Sewer Equipment Sales did not respond to the inquiry.
- Macnaught USA did not respond to the inquiry.
- McKenna Brytan Industries do not carry the Thompson line.

The Procurement Ordinance authorizes negotiations in an IFB process when there is a sole bidder. As such, United Rentals (North America, Inc.) was contacted to negotiate the warranty and the indemnification provision provided by the bidder and the bidder agreed to a warranty period of 90 days or 100 hours, whichever occurs first. The indemnification provision provided by the bidder was reviewed by Risk Management and approved. Markdown for parts was confirmed with the bidder at a 10% from Manufacturer's List Price. Staff determined that bid prices are reasonable based upon comparison to current and past County contracts for similar services. United Rentals (North America, Inc.) meets all specifications and requirements of the IFB. Therefore, recommendation for award is made to United Rentals (North America, Inc.).
