Contribution:

The Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Florida inspire and enable all young people, especially those from disadvantaged circumstances, to realize their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens. By providing positive activities and encouragement, the Boys and Girls Clubs offer an alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today.
