**CONSENT AGENDA ITEM SEPTEMBER 14. 2021** 

The Pine Hills Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District Advisory Council (the "Council") is composed of seven members: two nominated by the Mayor, one nominated by the District 2 Commissioner, one nominated by the District 6 Commissioner, two nominated by the Pine Hills Community Council, and one nominated by the Pine Hills Safe Neighborhood Partnership. Representatives must be property owners or residents within the boundaries of the Pine Hills Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District. The Board appoints all Council members. Terms are for three years.

The term of the District 2 representative, Timothy S. Haberkamp, has expired. Commissioner Moore has nominated Jeff Reine to succeed Mr. Haberkamp in the District 2 representative category with a term expiring June 30, 2024.
