- SUBJECT: Master Agreement Y22-118, Annual Maintenance, Equipment and Technician Services for the E911 Positron Viper System

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to execute Master Agreement Y22-118 for Annual Maintenance, Equipment and Technician Services for the E911 Positron Viper System between Orange County, Florida and AT&T, in the total estimated amount of \$894,373.44 for a one-year term. Further request authorization of the Procurement Division to renew the contract for one additional one-year term.

PROCUREMENT:

This Master Agreement will provide Orange County Public Safety Answering Points with annual maintenance, equipment, and technicians for the E911 Positron Viper System. The annual maintenance period is October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1054-031-0677-3823.

APPROVALS:

The Information Systems and Services Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

In April 2010, the Board approved AT&T as the sole provider of 911 services. A comparison of prices for similar services in Seminole County and Brevard County was used to determine the reasonableness of the cost for this maintenance. While the systems at both of these agencies have some dissimilarities to the system at Orange County, price analysis indicated that the pricing for this service was consistent with the prices paid by these entities.
