SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" Signs on Tolworth Avenue

A concerned citizen has requested that "No Parking" signs be established on the north side of Tolworth Avenue from Marsfield Avenue to Burwood Avenue.

The request for parking restrictions is to address pedestrian safety incidences and hazardous driving conditions caused by vehicles parking on the north side of the road. Ballots were mailed to the property owners impacted. Upon receipt of the ballots confirming that two-thirds of residents are in favor of the "No Parking" signs, the County will proceed with the installation request. The result of the survey indicated that 70% of the property owners approve the "No Parking" signs.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs on the north side of Tolworth Avenue from Marsfield Avenue to Burwood Avenue.

Avenue. District 4.


