The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$267,193 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Forfeitures for the following purpose:

**Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Response Vehicle – \$267,193.** The funding will be used to purchase a new EOD Response Vehicle to respond to hazardous device calls in the tourist region of Orange County. This vehicle will also increase the Sheriff's Office ability to provide adequate security for relevant critical infrastructure and mass gathering events.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$267,193 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Forfeitures for Emergency Vehicles, Inc. EOD Response Vehicle.**

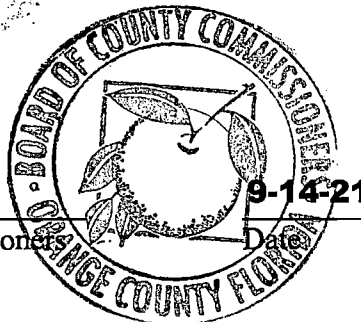
