On June 22, 2021, the Board accepted from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services an award for the Orange County Head Start Program in the amount of \$14,301,993. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has awarded the Orange County Head Start Program a cost of living adjustment in the amount of \$170,491, increasing the total grant award to \$14,472,484. Funding will be utilized to increase staff fringe benefits.
