Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$4,000 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

Contribution:

Concerns of Police Survivors – \$2,500. The Concerns of Police Survivors works to meet the needs of families and co-workers of honored ones that have fallen in the line of duty.

Victim Service Center – \$1,500. The Victim Service Center is a nonprofit organization which helps crime victims access services to utilize resources and translation services to assist victims with language barriers and provides basic emergency needs such as food and shelter.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$4,000 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to the Concerns of Police Survivors (\$2,500) and the Victim Service Center (\$1,500).

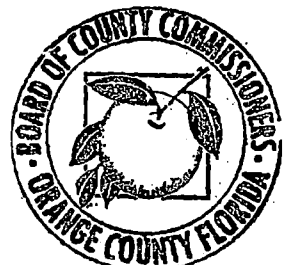
