SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" Signs on Narcoossee Road

A concerned citizen has requested that "No Parking" signs be established on the west side of Narcoossee Road from Clear Vista Street to Tyson Road.

The request for parking restrictions is to address pedestrian safety incidences and hazardous driving conditions caused by vehicles parking on the west side of the road. Additionally, Orange County Public Schools has raised concerns about vehicles having difficulty driving onto campus as several drivers park on Narcoossee Road and block the school vehicle entrance.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "No Parking, Stopping, Standing" signs on the west side of Narcoossee Road from Clear Vista Street to Tyson Road.

Action Requested: Approval of "No Parking, Stopping, Standing" signs installation on Narcoossee Road. District 4.



Narcoossee Rd at Tyson Rd Consent Agenda District Map




