SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y20-1092, Prenatal Care Services

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y20-1092, Prenatal Care Services, with the Department of Health, Orange County, in the amount of \$250,000, for a revised contract amount of \$630,000.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment adds funding to the contract, in the amount of \$250,000 to support expanding prenatal services to uninsured Orange County residents.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-060-2502-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Health Services Department concurs with this request.

REMARKS:

The Board approved Contract Y20-1092 on December 15, 2020 to Department of Health, Orange County, in the amount of \$380,000.

The program provides comprehensive prenatal care designed to identify members who are pregnant, encourage early and ongoing prenatal care, and increase member's access to perinatal information. Additional funding will allow for a broader population to be reached and supports the provision of comprehensive prenatal care by a licensed obstetrician to uninsured, underinsured and medically indigent residents of Orange County. The Florida Department of Health, Orange County, provides services by an obstetrics practice in the local medical community. Prenatal care is delivered in an obstetrics clinic and provided by a licensed obstetrician/nurse practitioner/nurse midwife. Case management is also provided to patients identified as high-risk pregnancies.
