On August 24, 2021, the Board approved the Local Provider Participation Fund (LPPF) Ordinance 2021-35, which authorizes the County to impose a non-ad valorem special assessment on for-profit and not-for-profit hospitals to fund the non-federal share of Medicaid payments benefitting hospitals providing healthcare services to Medicaid, indigent, and uninsured members of the Orange County Community.

This budget amendment is necessary to establish the budget for FY 2020-21 in the amount of \$148,912,216 to account for the funds collected by the County through the LPPF assessments where the portion permissible will then be sent to the state Agency for Health Care Administration. The state will receive the federal match and make payments to Medicaid managed care organizations pursuant to the terms of a letter of agreement that was approved by the Board on September 28, 2021.

On August 10, 2021, the Board accepted six Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants from the U.S. Department of Justice, through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, totaling \$143,329. Each of the six awards will be utilized to support approved law enforcement initiatives during the grant period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

The Orange County Sheriff's Office will utilize the funding as follows: \$9,407 to purchase six Wire Attack Piercer Probe kits for the Hazardous Devices Team; \$37,584 to purchase two motorized pole cameras for the Marine Unit; \$24,000 to purchase a license plate reader and associated equipment for the Uniform Patrol Division -Sector I and \$37,244 for Sector II; \$15,854 for the training of 30 sworn and civilian agency personnel; and lastly, \$19,240 to purchase mountain bicycles and associated equipment for the Emergency Response Team.
